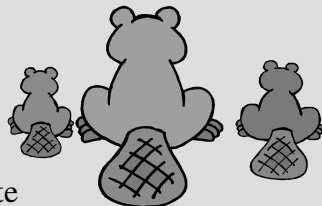

DAVID STOKES, Award-winning Environmental Educator, will provide hands-on nature education for children and will entertain all with humor, songs and live animals.

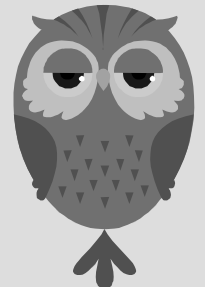

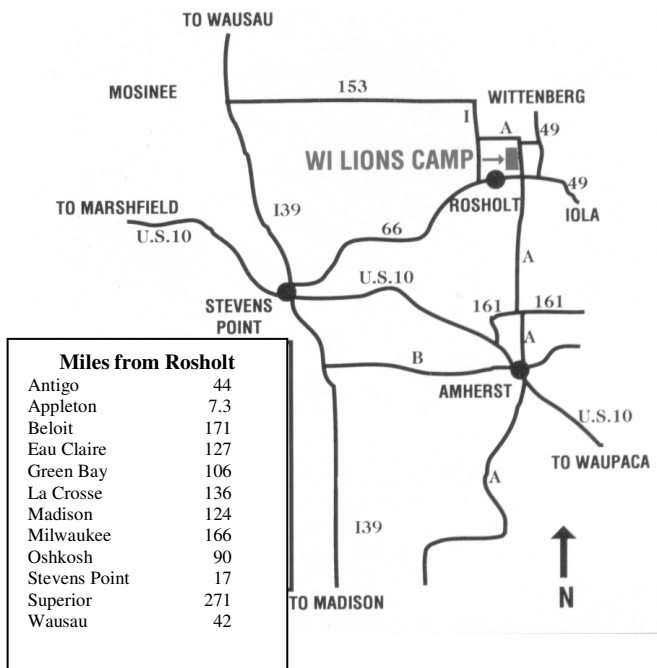
Dates
